Hamilton stars in the new, *Into the Blue*

Hamilton gets into extremely deep water with its latest movie appearance in Columbia Pictures release of MGM Pictures' action adventure *Into the Blue* set for release on September 30, 2005 in the U.S.

Hold your breath as Paul Walker (*The Fast and the Furious*) and Jessica Alba (*Sin City*) star in a tense, exciting underwater action/adventure set in the dangerous, shark-infested waters of the Bahamas.

When four, young, free divers come upon a legendary shipwreck - rumored to contain millions in gold - they believe their dream of buried treasure has come true. But nearby, on the ocean floor, they unearth another, more sinister, mystery. The fortune-hunting friends make a pact to keep quiet about both discoveries so they can excavate the shipwreck before a rival treasure hunter discovers their secret and beats them to the gold. But with so much at stake, their loyalties are tested. Facing hidden dangers at every turn, the hunters suddenly become the hunted.

With threatening bad guys on his heels, one of the divers, played by Paul Walker, chooses a Hamilton *Khaki Navy* watch to keep him on track. The watch also can keep a secret – something his collaborators find increasingly difficult.

The *Khaki Navy* passes many tough tests in *Into the Blue*. Both water resistance and robustness emerge as heroes as the action-packed plot unfolds. The watch is perfect for its role in the movie with water resistance to a depth of 200 meters and an internal turning bezel to measure time elapsed under water. It also passes the audition to play the part of 'lost treasure' with a silver-colored dial and metal bracelet, plus a sapphire glass and top quality Swiss automatic movement. Hamilton has also appeared in such Hollywood movies as *Men in Black*, *Men in Black 2*, *Charlie's Angels*, *S.W.A.T* among many others.
